

The short course in Interior Design and Styling prepares learners for a rewarding career in the interior design industry. PHOTO GRAPHY

Fashion Photography forms a pivotal part of any fashion story. As a genre, it is an art form that focuses on capturing clothing and other items that depict a certain mood, personality, and style of fashion. Fashion photography also happens to be a fundamental element of the entire process of the creation of a promotional and advertising campaign for a brand, product or even an individual.

It plays a vital role in how the audience perceives the brand or human element.

Selection of location, accessories, model, clothes, arrangement of elements in the frame, all come together to form a fashion photograph that is worthy of a quality fashion editorial or ad campaign. A professional and creative fashion photographer is essential for the success of a fashion brand or product. The range of work asked for as part of the profession include creating the visual elements for catalogues, lookbooks, window displays of retail stores.

Top fashion photographers collaborate with the chief editors of fashion magazines during the creation of photo editorials to interpret a fashion product in the most impactful and memorable manner. They also work with an extended team, discussing and incorporating the works of other professionals such as fashion stylists, make-up artists and art directors to create an aesthetic piece of art through fashion.

The short course on Fashion Photography familiarizes participants with the production and planning of shots, selection of garments and accessories, choosing locations and working within a team.

The short course on Fashion Photography will aim to bring out Individual creativity and develop an aesthetic sense for fashion through an understanding conceptual development.

Fashion Marketing and Entrepreneurship forms the business side of fashion because at the end of the day, fashion does serve a commercial purpose. It requires an integration of the creative and business aspects within the fashion industry.

Participants in the short programme for Fashion Marketing and Entrepreneurship can opt for careers in retail buying and visual merchandising or chart an independent path by becoming entrepreneurs. The short programme will shed an introductory light on the essential elements that go into fashion marketing and facilitate participants in identifying which specific area they would like to explore in greater detail, either through a full-time study programme in Fashion Marketing or through an internship in a fashion house or retail store.



INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS



All JDCL courses are taught in English. Please note that all candidates who first language is not English will be required to provide evidence of their proficiency in written and spoken English as well as their comprehension skills. An IELTS score of 5.5 is desirable. This is because the students are required to participate in class discussions and give presentations during the course of study. Please refer to www.ielts.org for further information.

If a candidate does not hold a UK, EU or EEA passport, our International Students' Admissions Office will provide assistance in filing and obtaining a student visitor's visa which permits her/him to study in the UK. JD Campus London supports all international

students through the visa process and provides the necessary paperwork for visa authorities as proof of study at the college.


